Expected Number. Variable Location: Online or in-person

Overview: the purpose of this is to provide a pool of funding for surgical or global health societies at individual medical schools to host events, workshops and tutorials related to Global Surgery. Societies hosting events would consult ASSA Global Surgery to gain access to this funding. We believe that local activities are the best way to increase the accessibility of Global Surgery, expanding awareness and increasing engagement with this important and under-recognised field.





LEADERSHIP DAY WEEKEND

February 2023



Expected Number: 80 participants, including all Surgical Society Presidents across Australasia **Location:** Victorian RACS (Royal Australasian College of Surgeons) Office and Online Hybrid delivery

Costs: Venue, Catering, Zoom Subscription, Tokens of Gratitude for Keynote Speakers

Event Overview: Involving keynotes, panels and breakout sessions, this two-day event is a unique opportunity for presidents and executives of all 26 surgical societies across Australia and New Zealand to convene, share ideas and learn from established leaders in surgery. Having run since ASSA's inauguration, this event has shown immense success in inspiring and equipping student leaders to support their local catchments!

On the second day of this jam-packed weekend, we have our ART course - an excellent upskilling opportunity for any interested future researchers. TASMAN's ART course is an exciting half-day workshop tailor-made for those with a budding interest in collaborative research but who are unsure about where to begin. While in previous years we have largely focused on introducing delegates to the "ins and outs" of collaborative research, last year marked a shift towards the "how", with the workshop geared towards equipping attendees with the practical knowledge and skills to begin directly participating in collaborative projects. This is an especially important priority for TASMAN, following up on the success of our homegrown collaborative research project, OPERAS.

STATE-BASED SURGICAL HUBS

August 2023



Expected Number: 160+ participants (40 participants per location)

Location: In-person across multiple locations in Australasia (NSW, QLD, VIC, NZ)

Costs: Venue, Catering, Equipment

Event Overview: Run for the first time in 2022, the SA and VIC Surgical Hub Workshops are a collaboration between ASSA and all of the individual surgical societies in each state. They were immensely successful in their first year running, and we plan on expanding them across more Australian states as well as New Zealand in 2023. These workshops offer an opportunity for medical students from universities across the state to collaborate over a variety of exciting surgical skills stations hosted at the respective RACS offices. The aim of this event is to develop important surgical skills in a hands-on, in-person format and fill a significant need for students to network amongst each other. The event will conclude with an opportunity for members to debrief and socialise amongst each-other and surgeons in attendance.

EMPoWER: WOMEN IN SURGERY

March 2023



Expected Number: 100+ participants

Location: Online platform

Costs: Tokens of Gratitude for Speakers

Event Overview: After successfully premiering in 2021, ASSA's "Empowering and Motivating Pre-SET Women in surgERy" (EMPoWER) event will return for the 3rd year running. Having been run as a collaboration between 4 surgical societies in 2022 and reaching over 100 medical students across Australasia, we are excited for further opportunities to expand this incredibly valuable event with more powerful speakers and greater collaboration between Australasian surgical societies. As a half-day seminar, members will have the opportunity to hear a number of keynote addresses from leading female surgeons, followed by opportunities to up-skill themselves through a variety of smaller breakout session workshops.

BEYOND THE STERILE FIELD

April - September 2023



Expected Number: 50 participants (per session)

Location: Online platform

Costs: Tokens of Gratitude for Speakers

Event Overview: A new mini-series which debuted in 2022, Beyond The Sterile Field is a series of informal chats that delve into unique & creative careers in surgery ranging from rural surgery, military surgery, and indigenous surgery. Each session will feature a distinguished guest speaker who will share stories from their experiences in the field and be involved in a Q&A session with inspired students across Australia & New Zealand. Sessions will be one-hour in length and allow students to gain understanding into crucial but frequently less explored areas of surgery.

July 2023



Expected Number: 300+ participants

Location: Online platform


Costs: Tokens of Gratitude for Speakers

Event Overview: One of ASSAs largest events with over 300 registrations in 2022, "So You Want To Be A Surgeon?" offers an opportunity for all medical students to hear about the pathway into surgical training directly from those who are already been through the journey. Delivered virtually over Zoom, this event will provide a plethora of information to medical students regarding the various pathways of a surgical career. The first session will consist of a keynote presentation from a RACS trainee on the general pathway into surgical training, followed by 9 breakout sessions which will address the specifics of each of the different RACS surgical specialities with up to 2 RACS trainee representatives in each session.

WHAT CAN WE DO FOR YOUR ORGANISATION?


With over 20,000 medical students amongst 26 student surgical societies across Australia and New Zealand, ASSA is the largest student surgical society across both nations providing connections between various surgical societies. 




